

ENEOS Supplies Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) to American Airlines

ENEOS Corporation (Head Office: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; hereinafter "ENEOS") announces that it has supplied **American Airlines**, **Inc.** (Head Office: Fort Worth, Texas; hereafter referred to as "American Airlines") with Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF).

ENEOS aims to provide a stable supply of energy, including SAF, to the aviation industry, and with this delivery of SAF to American Airlines, ENEOS is demonstrating that it can support the aviation industry in its goal to achieve net-zero CO2 emissions. The SAF, which is derived from used cooking oil, is scheduled to be supplied on American Airlines' flights from Haneda to New York and will represent American's first delivery of SAF in Japan.

As stated in the ENEOS Group's Long-Term Vision, ENEOS is taking on the challenge of achieving both a stable supply of energy and materials and the realization of a carbon-neutral society. Promoting the spread of domestically produced SAF is important for accelerating decarbonization in the aviation industry, and ENEOS is building an integrated system for SAF, from Feedstock procurement to in-house manufacturing and sales.
