Effects of the Great Tohoku Earthquake #8

EM Japan Group companies continued efforts on multiple fronts to bring stable supply to the stricken areas. In addition to steady operation of the refineries, the opening of Shiogama Terminal has made product transport to the Tohoku area much easier. See more detailed information as follows.

- With Chiba Refinery's expected full production on March 21, all refineries of the ExxonMobil Japan Group will be fully operational.

2. Status of terminals

All terminals are operating normally, with the exception of Siogama Terminal near Sendai (see below).

3. Product shipment to Tohoku Area

- The Shiogama Terminal in Sendai opened at 9am today (March 20) for the first time since the great earthquake and delivered about 160,000 Liters of products from the terminal today. The port is expected to open tomorrow (March 21). The terminal is shared with other companies in order to accelerate resupply of the critically-impacted Sendai area.
- TonenGeneral Sekiyu's Kawasaki refinery continues to deliver to terminal in Utsunomiya, from where a part of that is shipped to the Tohoku Area by tank-trucks.
- TonenGeneral Sekiyu's Wakayama refinery and Kyokuto Petroleum Inc.'s Chiba refinery are filling and shipping hundreds of 200-liter drums of kerosene and diesel for emergency use in the stricken areas. 100 drums with MG/ Kero/ ADO arrived at SDF's Iruma (Saitama-Pref.) base

today from Wakayama. They will be transferred to the Tohoku Area by SDF. 160 drums with Kerosene were dispatched to Tagajo (Miyagi-Pref.) of SDF today.

- Barge shipment to joint terminals at Niigata, Akita, Aomori is undergoing.
